

**ORDER**

**Sub: Restriction on the number of vehicles and people allowed at the time of nomination in Zilla Panchayat election.**

In exercise of the powers vested in it under Article 243K of the Constitution of India read with Section 237 of the Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 and with a view to avoid crowding by the supporters of the candidates in the office of the RO at the time of filing nomination; following directions are issued by the Commission for compliance by all concerned :

All the Returning Officers /Asstt. Returning Officers must inform various political parties and interest groups that the maximum number of vehicles that will be allowed to come within the periphery of 100 mtrs of Returning Officer's /Asstt. Returning Officer's office at the time of filing the nomination shall be three. Similarly, the total number of persons allowed will be not more than six : **candidate plus five** other individuals which may include any proposer / proposers proposing the nomination of the candidate i.e there can be only six people ( including the candidate) who can remain present inside the Returning Officer's / Asstt. Returning Officer's room at the time of filing nomination.
